1st Annual Walk For CHIARI

Chiari Malformation is an uncommon congenital birth defect of the brain that affects 1 in 1,000 people. It is a condition where the brain pushes down into the spinal canal, causing severe headaches, dizziness, pain, difficulty swallowing, sleep apnea, vision problems, hearing loss, and a wide range of other symptoms. It can also lead to hydrocephalus and/or syringomyelia.

The only treatment for this debilitating condition is management of symptoms and/or brain surgery. The surgery is minimally successful, with subsequent surgeries usually necessary. Because Chiari Malformation is a rare condition, it is not well understood, even in the medical community. To better understand this condition and ultimately find a cure, we need research.
